## SAFETY ZONE

### **Get the Right Trip Planning Info!**

- Stay up to date on weather and road conditions, detours, and mountainous routes in order to plan driving time.
- Be aware that non-commercial navigation systems and apps may not provide warning of height and weight limitations and other commercial vehicle restrictions.

### **Hard enforcement for truckers beginning May 1<sup>st</sup>!**

Authorities in Pennsylvania will start 'hard enforcement' of a new permit for truckers who make stops in the quarantine zone for an invasive species of insect starting this week. Starting on May 1, some businesses that operate in one of the fourteen Pennsylvania counties that are Spotted Lanternfly quarantine zones must obtain and carry a permit showing that the company is in compliance with insect inspection and control training. Companies that are based in the quarantine zone, load in the quarantine zone, or that make stops in the quarantine zone all must obtain the permit.

- o The 14 counties under quarantine include Berks, Bucks, Carbon, Chester, Dauphin, Delaware, Lancaster, Lebanon, Lehigh, Monroe, Montgomery, Northampton, Philadelphia, and Schuylkill.
