The Iowa 80 Truckstop Hy-Vee Pharmacy to offer COVID-19 vaccine clinics starting Monday, May 10.

The clinics are open to anyone ages 18 and older and will be conducted on the third floor of the main building at the Iowa 80. Both the Pfizer and the Johnson & Johnson single shot vaccines will be offered.

Fireworks haulers seek multiyear ELD waiver.

Fireworks display companies have warned regulators that Fourth of July celebrations are at stake due to federal work-rule and electronic logging device (ELD) restrictions. FMCSA is asking for comments on applications from the APA, which is requesting that expired waivers from the restrictions be renewed. Without this exemption, America's traditional celebrations of Independence Day would be at risk.



Congress starts down road to automatic braking mandate.

Legislation introduced this week on Capitol Hill requiring automatic emergency braking (AEB) and lane-assist technology on all new trucks is being praised by safety advocates but rejected by small-business truckers. It requires advanced driver assistance systems, including AEB, lane-departure warning, lane-keeping assist and blind-zone detection systems on commercial vehicles weighing over 10,000 pounds.
