## **TRUCKER CHAT**

**Top winter weather driving tips for TRUCKERS! Safety comes first in EVERY season!**

See and BE SEEN! When there is low visibility on the roadway, you must be extra aware of your surroundings.

- Clear off all snow off your mirrors, windows, lights, etc.
- Watching for break lights on vehicles ahead of you.
- Checking that your own lights are on and working properly.
- Waiting for cars hidden in the cloud of snow created by your vehicle.
- Using your air conditioner to help keep windows defrosted. Remember, conditioned air is dry.

### **REMEMBER.....**

- diesel exhaust fluid (DEF) begins to freeze at 32° F and try and keep vehicles running not idling
- Allow safe space
- Watch out for bridges
- Brake slowly
- Use bunk heaters and/or an auxiliary power unit (APU) to stay warm when it gets cold
