TRUCKER CHAT

I95 Reopens! After being closed to traffic for 12 days, the damaged section of Interstate 95 through Philadelphia reopened! A tanker truck fire beneath the interstate on June 11 caused one bridge to collapse and left another heavily damaged. According to the Bureau of Transportation Statistics, trucks carry millions of tons of freight and billions in dollar-value through the region annually. In 2021, trucks carried 21 million tons of freight worth \$104 billion between major goods-producing and consuming areas to the north and south of the Philadelphia region.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration on June 22 announced a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) that would require heavy vehicles to have automatic emergency braking (AEB) systems to mitigate the frequency and severity of rear-end crashes.
