SAFETY ZONE

BACK TO SCHOOL! With back-to-school month being here and approaching quickly please remember restrictions and regulations while driving through school zones. Reduce your speed when traveling through school zones. Depending on the type of roadway the school zone is in, this speed limit could be as low as 10 or 15 mph. Regardless, the speed limit in school zones will be significantly lower than what is posted on other areas of the same roadway.
